# Housing



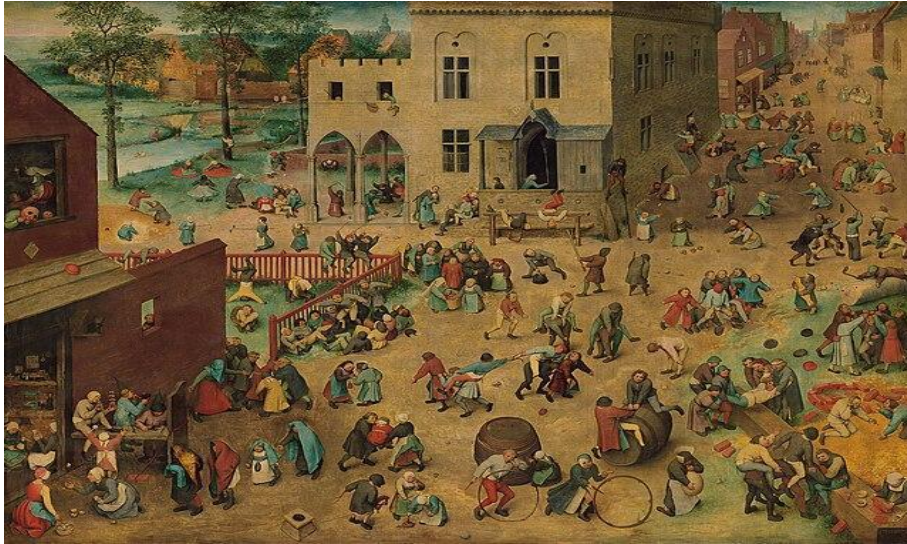
